Students participate in a career-based field trip to a private corporation, cultural institution, or government agency for a full-day experience designed to connect students' understanding of their current course of study and future career options.

Provides students with a full-day experience designed to expose students to the diversity in STEM careers, options for postsecondary STEM education and pathways to STEM careers.

Last Dollars Scholarship

We work to reduce the financial burdens of a college education. Our Philadelphia Scholars **Last Dollar Scholarship**—the largest non-university-based scholarship program in Philadelphia—awards \$600,000 in aid annually. Students with unmet financial needs may apply to receive up to \$7,500 annually through this scholarship. Additionally, PEF manages several scholarships that are offered exclusively to CAP participants each year.



Additional Programs

These programs are sponsored by PEF and open to both CAP participants and non-participating students.

Fostering College Readiness



This program targets high school students who are experiencing or have experienced foster care through the Department of Human Services at any point after their 16th birthday.

Students receive access to the Lenfest Immensitas Scholarship for college room & board and individualized college counseling.

Scholars Advantage



Scholars Advantage is a unique summer opportunity for Philadelphia youth attending public high schools to earn stipends while improving their skills in English composition, computer science & coding, and human anatomy & physiology.

Yleana Leadership Academy



Sponsored Yleana Leadership Foundation, the summer academy prepares students to be the best college applicants through elite test preparation, application assistance, critical thinking, and persistence skills, mixed with traditional summer fun.

Last Dollars Scholarship

Trabajamos para reducir las cargas financieras de una educación universitaria. Nuestros becarios de Filadelfia **Last Dollars Scholarship** –el mayor programa de becas no universitario en Filadelfia– otorga 600,000 dólares en ayuda anualmente. Los estudiantes que necesiten ayuda financiera para la universidad pueden solicitar recibir hasta \$7,500 anualmente a través de esta beca. Además, el PEF gestiona varias becas que se ofrecen exclusivamente a los participantes del CAP cada año.

Fostering College Readiness



Este programa está dirigido a estudiantes de secundaria que están experimentando o han experimentado cuidado de crianza (“foster care” en inglés) a través del Departamento de Derechos Humanos Servicios en cualquier momento después de cumplir 16 años. Estos estudiantes también reciben acceso a la beca Lenfest Immensas para costear el precio de dormitorios y recibir servicios de consejería

Scholars Advantage es una oportunidad de verano única para los jóvenes de escuela superior en Filadelfia para ganar estipendios mientras mejoran sus habilidades en composición en inglés, informática y codificación, y anatomía humana y fisiología.

Yleana Leadership Academy
