Additional Details Staff Follow-Up: Safety Incident and Next Steps 12.3.24

Dear Team,

Thank you again for your professionalism and composure during the incident before the break. I want to provide additional details about last Wednesday's events and outline the steps we've taken since then. While student confidentiality limits what I can share, I hope the following updates address some of your concerns.

Incident Recap and Actions Taken

During morning admission, the weapons detection system flagged a potential weapon in a student's backpack. Following established protocols, we initiated a lockdown and conducted a classroom-by-classroom search in collaboration with the Philadelphia Police Department, including the use of munitions detection dogs.

As a result of a thorough investigation involving our climate team, school safety officers, and police, we identified several students of interest. Today, a meeting with the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities resulted in a plan of action to hold students accountable according to the district's Code of Conduct. The accountability process began this morning.

Safety Protocol Review and Next Steps

We have reviewed our morning admissions procedures and conducted staff retraining to reinforce safety measures. A safety team meeting this morning identified next steps for school-wide safety initiatives. Additionally, our counseling team, STEP Team, and district prevention/intervention support personnel coordinated to provide long-term support for students and staff.

We will engage with community partners:

- Network of Neighbors Meeting: December 13, 2024 (actions TBD)
- **FPCN Collaboration:** December 16, 2024, 3:00–3:30 PM in the IMC (focused on mindfulness and stress reduction).

Additional long-term plans will be addressed in the new year.

Mental Health Support

The holiday season can heighten stress for both students and staff. To support well-being:

- Counseling Space for Students: Located in the IMC for those needing a talk to a trusted adult or peer. JBHS Mental Health Resources Guide
- **Staff Support:** Lyra Health professionals will be available on-site Tuesday and Wednesday in the parent conference room.
